2019 INFORMATIONAL SHEET

GIRLS SOFTBALL: (rookie level ages 7-8, minors age 9 & 10, majors ages 11 & 12, must have reached stated age by Jan. 1) As part of the Franklin County Softball League Games will be played at Kineowatha Park and at other towns in Franklin county. (You will receive a game schedule with sites listed.) **Games day will be Sundays for Rookies, Tuesday/Thursday for U10 and Mondays/Wednesday for U12.** Once team rosters have been set, your coach will call to tell you what team you are on and when practices will begin. You will need to provide your own glove; (the rec dept. has a box of used gloves; (the rec dept. has a box of used gloves people can choose from it they wish) the Rec Department will issue you a team jersey **which must be returned at the end of the season.** Or you can purchase one with your name on it to keep. The rules of the game have been modified to fit this age level to help insure that **fun and learning** are part of the players' experience.

ROOKIE BASEBALL: (7-10yrs. old must be 7 by May 1) (11 & 12yr olds must signup for Cal-Ripken) Games will be played at Kineowatha Park and at AYS sites in the Jay/Livermore/LF on Mondays and Wednesdays at 5:30pm. The first 30 minutes will be set aside for skill development then teams will play a 4-inning game. Pitching will be done with a pitching machine as well as live pitching by coaches or players. You will receive a team jersey **which must be returned at the end of the season** and a hat **which you must pay for** and get to keep. You must provide your own glove. Once team rosters have been set your coach will call you and tell you which team you are on and when practices will be.

T-BALL (5 & 6-year old, must be 5 by May 1) All games will be played at Kineowatha Park on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 5:30pm. The first 30 minutes will be set aside for skill development; teams will then play a two or three inning game depending on the time it takes to play the first two innings. The first inning all players will hit from the tee. The second inning coaches will pitch to the players (10 pitch limit) if a third inning is played players can choose to hit live or off the tee. Once team rosters have been set you will be called by your coach to let you know which team you are on and when practices will be. **You must provide you own glove and pay for your hat and shirt which players get to keep.**

ALL LEVELS: The rec department has supply of used gloves; please speak to the rec director or your coach if you need one. Anyone wishing to help with coaching can speak to the rec director or directly to your child's coach. ****PLAY BALL!****
