PUC has approved the rate increase for 2023 & 2024

The water line project will continue to be reviewed and necessary permits filed. Budget processes are to begin in January beginning with a timeline at the first meeting in January. Tiffany is requesting the budget and spreadsheet information when available.

Perry is working on spreadsheets for Union negotiations.

Minimum Wage increases to \$13.80 January 1, 2023. Social Security increases by 8.7%.

The Public Works crew worked 30 plus hours with the initial storm with zero accidents and minimal complaints.

The Parks and Rec Director, Frank Donald is transitioning to Part time status as of January 1, 2023. A weekly stipend will be paid.
